Approximate the wound edges together.

Holding the device upright, squeeze the device between thumb and forefinger to break the glass ampoule.

Apply adhesive in a thin film over the length of the wound. Hold the wound closed for 60 seconds to complete the bond. 0.75ml provides wound coverage of over 20cm<sup>11</sup>.
